Open sights- adjustable or fixed sights only- No Peeps* Except for our primitive-only event where flintlock ignition and fixed open sights is a requirement.**

1. 25 yard- 5 shot off-hand turkey head **\$2.00**
2. 50 yard- 5 shot off-hand NSSF Bull **\$2.00**

Ladies' Re-entry targets- \$2.00 a target

3. 25 yard- 5 shot off-hand little black buffalo **\$2.00**
4. 50 yard- 5 shot off-hand Pie Bear **\$2.00**

Off Hand Aggregate

5. 25 yd off-hand 5 shot crow
6. 25 yd off-hand 5 shot (2 in each full bull, 1 in the half bull) mini Fur De Lac
7. 50 yd off-hand 5 shot 6 bull target
8. 50 yd off-hand 5 shot running deer

Hunters Aggregate- (any position- over log/X stick/sitting/prone)

9. 50yd any position 5 shot All Black Buffalo
10. 50yd any position 5 shot Double Bull Buffalo
11. 50yd any position 5 shot 3 Bull

Ladies Aggregate

12. 25yd off-hand 5 shot squirrel
13. 25yd off-hand 5 shot running rabbit
14. 50yd off-hand 5 shot running chuck
15. 50yd off-hand 5 shot Fur De Lac

Marksman Aggregate Flint or Cap (can be shot by any registered shooter, but a shooter placing in a PRIZE WINNING slot in any other muzzleloader shooting aggregate, including Woods Walk and Iron Valley will have their score removed from this aggregate)

16. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Rabbit
17. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Candle
18. 50yd off-hand 5 shot Heart
19. 50yd off-hand 5 shot 7 Ring Bull

Pistol Aggregate- one hand hold*

20. 25 yd off-hand 5 shot pistol target
21. 50 yd off-hand 5 shot pistol target

Smoothbore Aggregate (sighted or unsighted)

22. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Standing Groundhog
23. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Skunk Butt
24. 50yd off-hand 5 shot 8 ring black Big Bull

Junior Aggregate * under 16* (use of cross sticks/bi-pod/tripod considered for age and ability)

****juniors may re-enter at no cost to improve score.**

25. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Jug
26. 25yd off-hand 5 shot Moose
27. 50yd off-hand 5 shot Standing Bear

*****No Spotting Scopes and other binoculars allowed on the firing line*****

Shooters must be in 1750-1840's primitive costume. Patched roundball **and flintlock ignition only, fixed-non-adjustable sights**. Shooters must load from the bag and horn, no range-rods. Ramrods must be constructed of traditional materials. See NMLRA primitive rules for complete details. This shoot will be held on the Big Bore range at **9:00 am SATURDAY ONLY**. Shooters should be prepared for 7 shots.
